Payment Options:**Fee for Service Students**

Deposit of 10% or no less than \$200 whichever is the greater is required prior to commencement of course.

Fortnightly or monthly payments must be paid as per direct debit payment schedule. Payment must be made in full eight (8) weeks prior to course completion date.

Skills First Funded Students

Full payment of \$500 prior to commencement of course

or

Applications involve participation in the development of strategic initiatives as well as personal responsibility and autonomy in performing complex technical operations or organising others. It may include participation in teams, including those concerned with planning and evaluation functions. Group or team coordination may be involved.
